STUDENT EXPECTATIONS

- Each chaperone will be assigned a group of students. The students must always stay with this group unless they are given direct permission from their assigned chaperone.
- Students must always travel in groups of 3 to the restrooms or other designated areas and always with permission.
- Whenever students are on the bus, students must sit with a student of the same gender..
- No guys are allowed in the girls rooms and no girls are allowed in the boys rooms. No exceptions.
- After lights out, no one is allowed to exit their rooms until breakfast.
- Dress code:
 - close-toed shoes are required for activities
 - shorts are allowed (no higher than mid-thigh)
 - jeans are allowed,
 - sweatshirts or hoodies are recommended for the evening.
- Any inappropriate treatment (bullying, taunting, name calling, etc.) toward fellow students or teachers will be appropriately disciplined.
